

Fill-in and Fit-in

When you are leaving your photos in to be printed, you may choose the option *Fill-in* or *Fit-in*.

Fill-In is the standard, default setting.

Fill-In Explained

Most compact cameras take photos in a 4:3 ratio. What this means is that if you select a 6x4 size print (a 3:2 ratio), the whole sheet will be filled, but this may result in parts of your image being cropped.

Example:



(The darker area is not printed)

Fit-In Explained

If cropping the image does not suit you, as you need the whole image printed, you may choose to print as Fit-In.

If we take the same photo, and choose to print it as a 6x4 Fit-In, it will put the whole image on the sheet without cropping any of the image.
